

# User Permissions for Find Unapplied Credits (Transactions menu)

Several User Permissions are related to the **Find Unapplied Credits** (*Transactions* menu) feature and its search results.



User Permissions play a crucial role in protecting your data by controlling who can access, modify, or perform specific actions in your system. Review [Protect Your Account - User Permission Guidelines](#) for more information.

To adjust a User's permissions, go to the **Gear** icon > **Settings** > **Users & Permissions** > **User IDs** (click on a UserID) > **User Permissions** (left menu) to set the permissions. **Note: If a User is logged in when changes are made to their permissions, they'll have to log out and back in for the changes to take effect.**

## Permissions Related to Find Unapplied Credits

Category	User Permissions	Enables access to
<b>Transactions</b>	Find Unapplied Credits, Mass Edit Transactions	Mass apply credits; can update several transactions. Use the <b>Transactions</b> menu > <b>Find Unapplied Credits</b> to find and apply credits.
<b>Reports</b>	Transaction Search	<i>Search</i> and <i>Recent Transactions</i> from the <i>Transactions</i> menu.
<b>Families</b>	View Family Page	View and edit the details of a family. Click on a family's name from the <i>Family/Accts</i> column to view the family's record.
	Transactions Tab	View the <i>Transactions</i> tab from a family's record.
	Edit Transaction	View and edit a single transaction in the following ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Transactions</i> (menu) &gt; <i>Find Unapplied Credits</i> &gt; <i>Search</i> results grid &gt; <i>Pencil</i> (icon)</li><li>• <i>Transactions</i> (menu) &gt; <i>Find Unapplied Credits</i> &gt; <i>Search</i> results grid &gt; <i>View Transaction Link Details</i> (icon) &gt; <i>Pencil</i> (icon)</li></ul>
	Delete Transaction	Use the <b>Transactions</b> menu > <b>Find Unapplied Credits</b> > <b>Search</b> results grid > <b>Trash Can</b> (icon) to delete a single transaction.
