

# Compare Activities in Jackrabbit

In Jackrabbit, **Events**, **Classes**, and **Appointments** are each designed for specific scheduling needs. While they may appear similar at a glance, they are created and managed differently and serve unique purposes in your organization's operations.

The table below summarizes key similarities and differences between activities in Jackrabbit.

Purpose	One-time or limited-time occurrences (birthday parties, parents' night out, etc.)	Ongoing or recurring group instruction	One-time or recurring one-on-one/small group offerings (private lessons, evaluations, room rentals, etc.)
Enrollment	Enrollment by family or by student  Note: A family status remains inactive if a student enrolls in an event. For the family to become active, a student must be enrolled in a class or an appointment.	Students are enrolled in classes	Students are booked into appointments
