Grids in Jackrabbit organize data into rows and columns. Most grids hide some columns by default, but you can easily show or hide them to display the information you need.

- 1. From the grid, click on the Edit Column Settings icon (three vertical dots) in any of the column headers.
- 2. Choose the Columns option to display the list of available columns of information.
- 3. Select (to show) or clear (to hide) the checkboxes to customize the columns to be included in the grid.

The grid will refresh to include only the selected columns.
